Parent Code of Conduct

Gold Cal Jrs Volleyball Club desires all participants to have a positive, fun experience during the volleyball season. **GCJVBC** strives to create and provide a competitive atmosphere where camaraderie and mutual support are two elements players experience as part of their Club commitment. **Parents** are required to adhere to the **Code of Conduct** as described below for **Player** (name) _____.

Each Parent attending practices/tournaments are required to read, initial and sign where indicated below.

1. (____) (____) Parents acknowledge, **failure to follow** the **Code of Conduct** can/may result in sanctions by the leagues, NCVA and JSA toward the player, parent, team and the Club.
2. (____) (____) Parents are **not** to discuss concerns or problems with coaches during practices or tournaments. In the event of a problem, parents are required to wait **48 hours** before contacting the coach.
3. (____) (____) Parents will respect coaches, the Club Director, Team Parent, team members and their own team player during the Club season.
4. (____) (____) Parents will be courteous and respectful of other teams, players, referees, scorekeepers and line judges. Swearing at, shouting at or physical shoving of other players, parents, coaches or officials **are prohibited**.
5. (____) (____) Parents will ensure players inform their coaches, **well in advance**, when they will miss or be late to a practice or tournament.
6. (____) (____) Parents will cheer for their athlete and team members in a positive manner. Back stabbing, trash talking or criticizing coaches, players and other parents or other teams **is prohibited**.
7. (____) (____) Parents will acknowledge and obey all rules at practice and tournament facilities. When traveling, parents will be respectful of hotels and their guests, keeping noise to a minimum and will not trash hotel rooms or facilities.
8. (____) (____) Parents will stay respectfully away from the immediate playing areas during matches. Parents may **not** address the teams, coaches, players and **especially the officials** during matches.
9. (____) (____) Parents will be supportive of their athlete and will maintain a positive attitude. Parents will encourage diligent work and honest effort, on and of the court that will lead to improved performance and participation.
10. (____) (____) Parents will respect the coaching decisions during matches and **maintain a spectator role**. The roles that players are asked to perform, and the time in which they are asked to play is the absolute domain of the coach and **not** the parent.
11. (____) (____) Parents will provide player with proper nutrition and hydration during the Club season. This is especially necessary at tournaments when parents may not be in attendance. It is of vital importance to send proper food and water with your player when you are not able to attend a tournament. Do **not** expect on there being a snack bar or restaurants nearby for your player to acquire food.
12. (____) (____) Parents will ensure players arrive at practice a minimum of **10 minutes** if not more, prior to start time and be completely ready to begin practice. This includes having shoes tied, kneed pads on, ankle braces on, etc.
13. (____) (____) Parents will ensure players have transportation to and from practices and tournaments, promptly picking up their player.
14. (____) (____) Parents will assist their player in resolving issues respectfully, maintaining a cooperative and reasonable demeanor while doing so.
